Upcoming Worship

Ascension Day is the fortieth day after Easter (Thursday, May 9th), when Christ ascended into heaven (Acts 1:1 –

11). The ascension of Jesus serves as the prelude to Pentecost, when the power of the risen Christ came upon all believers through the Holy Spirit. We will celebrate the Ascension on the following Sunday, May 12.

On Sunday, May 19th, we will celebrate Pentecost, which is the fiftieth and last day of the Easter Season, when the Church received the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2).

The Sunday after Pentecost (May 26th) is a celebration of the Trinity: one God in three persons.

Beginning on June 2nd, we move into Ordinary Time.
