Offer rides to those who may not be able to come to church without help.

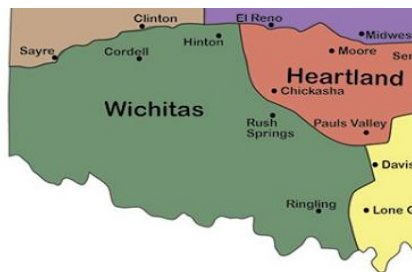
